MOTOR VEHICLE GRADING CRITERIA

1. Drivers must have a valid driver's license of the State they reside in.
2. Drivers should have at least two years driving experience and be at least 18 years old.
3. In the Past three (3) years, drivers should have no more than:
 - a.) Two (2) At-Fault Accidents, (proof of not-at-fault status for accidents must be received to rescind this)
 - b.) Three (3), Minor Moving Violations, (personal and /or business)
 - Stop sign and traffic signal offenses
 - Speeding
 - Improper turns, failure to signal, failure to yield
 - Operating a defective vehicle
 - Failure to observe a funeral procession
 - Seat belt violation
 - c.) Four (4) Non-Moving Violations such as:
 - Failure to Appear (FTA)
 - Unlicensed Driver, or
 - No Proof of Insurance/Registration
 - d.) Four (4) or more in combination of the above a, b, and c.
4. In the past four (4) years, drivers should have zero (0) Major Moving Violations such as:
 - Driving while suspended/revoked
 - Exhibition of speed- speed contest
 - Reckless driving
 - Driving under the influence (DUI)
 - Vehicular manslaughter
 - Leaving the scene of an accident, (Hit and Run), etc...
